



Tuesday Handgun & Sporter Rifle Practice

- Purpose:** To provide an opportunity to enjoy the shooting sports in a safe and relaxed social setting while developing marksmanship skills.
- Date:** Every Tuesday starting May 5, 2009 through and including August 25, 2009.
3 pm till dusk (rain or shine)
- Sponsor:** GRRC Handgun Silhouette Committee
- Location:** GRRC pistol range (the range is handicapped accessible)
- Entry fee:** **Adults** - \$5.00 per Tuesday **Juniors** - \$2.50 per Tuesday Both include tax
- Eligibility:** Open to all GRRC members and guests. Eligible guns include black powder and smokeless powder handguns as well as .22 rimfire and black powder small bore (squirrel) rifles. Target velocity ammunition (1000 fps or less) is preferred. Centerfir rifle ammunition is not allowed.
- Registration:** No pre-registration. Registration will be on a “first come - first serve” basis. All shooters on the range must sign-in before going on the firing line. If all available shooting stations are filled, shooters will be expected to rotate in order to provide opportunities for every one to shoot. Shooters may attend as many as or as few Tuesdays as they desire.
- Course of fire:**
Shooting will be done in 5 minute intervals at paper targets. There are no prescribed number of shots. Any safe shooting position is allowed and some shooting benches and sandbags will be available. All shooters will fire from the 50 yard line. Target stands can be placed at 15 - 50 yds out from the firing line at the shooters option. A variety of paper targets will be provided for handguns and 22 rifles along with scorecards. Shooters may bring their own paper targets.
- Safety rules:** Everyone on the range must follow the instructions of the range safety officer. Safe gun handling practices must be observed at all times. All firearms on the range (north of the creek) will be unloaded and cased except while on the firing line during a designated 5 minute firing interval. Holsters are not acceptable cases! Only “precision” aimed fire is permitted. No “off the hip” or “quick draw” firing will be allowed! Shooters must wear eye and ear protection while on the range.
- Parking:** Ample parking is available south of the road leading to the pistol range. No vehicles will be allowed on the north side of the range road except for those of handicapped shooters.
- Food:** Barbeque grills will be available along with free hot dogs and soft drinks. Participants may bring a “pot luck” item if they wish.
